



IAS Admission Appeals Timetable for Year 7 in September 2020

All appeals organised by the **Independent Appeals Service** will follow the timetable below:

National notification date for on-time applicants	Monday 2 March 2020
Notification date for late applicants (<i>for applications received after 31 October 2019 and before 2 March 2020</i>)	Tuesday 10 March 2020
Deadline date for parents wishing to lodge an appeal (<i>returning completed appeal papers to the County Council</i>)	Monday 30 March 2020
Year 7 appeal hearings to be held	From 04 May to 5 June 2020 (excluding the bank holiday on Friday 08 May)
Decision letters to be sent	Within 5 school days of hearing

Please note

- (i) Appeals lodged after 30 March 2020 will be heard during the above dates if possible, or within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged. Appeals lodged on or after 12 June 2020 may not be heard until the autumn term but no more than 30 school days after the appeal was lodged.
- (ii) Appellants will receive at least 10 school days' notice of the exact date and location of their appeal hearing.
- (iii) Following the lodging of an appeal, additional papers may be submitted to the Appeals Service until 10 working days before the hearing. Evidence admitted after this date will be considered by the panel but this may lead to an adjournment and significant delays.
