Put the Heart in Hartley is a community-based campaign introduced by Hartley Witney Senior & Junior Football Clubs, to raise £15,000 annually to host a heart screening event for the local young people of Hartley Wintney and surrounding areas whatever activity they undertake.

It can be hard to believe that a young person who appears fit and healthy may be at risk from heart problems, however every week in the UK at least 12 apparently fit and Healthy young people 35 years and under die from undiagnosed heart conditions.

Cardiac Screening is a very simple way of identifying young people at risk.

CRY is a national UK charity preventing young sudden cardiac deaths through awareness, screening and research as well as supporting affected families.

Booking an annual heart screening event through CRY will enable us as a community to identify young people at risk and hopefully prevent any of our community becoming one of the above statistics.

We will be hosting many community-based events to raise the funds. To enable us to book local screening days so that we can offer the young people of our community a free screening.

The first event will take place at the Hartley Wintney Football Club on Fri 12th of October and will be a catwalk fashion night. Tickets cost £5 and this includes a glass of Prosecco.
