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### USE OF MOBILE PHONES IN SCHOOL

The following message was shared with all students by their tutors this week. Please help to support us in operating a mobile phone free school during school hours by reminding your children of the consequences. In the case if an emergency please use the school reception as the contact between student and home so that adults in school can support you.

***'At Robert May's School mobile phones are not to be used between 0825 and 1425. This rule is similar to that of many other schools up and down the country. The rule exists because the main aim for being in school is learning. We believe that if you are sending and receiving messages during your school day, your focus is not on what you need to learn. We have also experienced a minority of students deliberately misusing their phones to cause upset to others. The rule also exists to safeguard all students from this sort of behaviour.***

***If you are seen using your mobile phone without having permission to do so, your teacher has a right to confiscate it. You do not have the right to argue about the confiscation because everybody knows the rule (it is published in the Home-School Agreement and in the School Behaviour Policy). If you choose to argue about it you will not only have the phone confiscated but also have a further sanction for rudeness, or defiance.***

***If your phone is confiscated, it will be locked in a safe in reception for the rest of the day. You can collect it at the end of the day. On the third occasion that your phone is confiscated, your parents will have to come into school to pick it up. Our suggestion is that you either turn off your phone at 0825 or that you put it in flight mode for the day. This is a reasonable request, and this notice is our final warning.***

## **BUS PASSES**

Please note the following messages regarding the Hampshire school buses and our Late Bus Service:

### **Hampshire Bus Passes (not the late bus service)**

Students must have their bus pass with them to guarantee travel on the school buses. Bus companies have the right to check student bus passes and may refuse travel if a valid bus pass cannot be shown. To avoid unnecessary upset and the inconvenience of having to come to school to collect your child please ensure they have their Hampshire bus pass with them every time they travel. If your child has lost their pass, please phone the Hampshire Passenger Transport Group on 01962 846924 to purchase a replacement.

### **Late Bus Passes**

Please remind any students using the Late Bus Service that they must keep their late bus pass safe. Students losing their late bus pass may purchase a replacement, or use the phone at reception to arrange alternative transport home.

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## **FREE LATE BUS PASSES FOR YEAR 11 REVISION SESSIONS**

Effective Monday 11th March, Year 11 students attending revision classes will be eligible for a free late bus pass if they wish to take the late bus home that day.

Registers will be taken by the teachers, during revision classes, in order for the School Office to identify students eligible for a free pass. It is the student's responsibility to ensure they are registered by the teacher *during the revision class*. If a student is not on a revision register they will not be given a free late bus pass but will be able to purchase one as usual. If you have a Year 11 student who would like to benefit from free late bus passes, please ensure they are aware of this.

Free late bus passes must be collected from reception, by the Year 11 student, after the second revision session has finished at at 3:30pm. They will *not* be available at break times, unless they wish to purchase a late bus pass for the usual £2.

Please be aware that seats on our late buses are limited and so free late bus passes are subject to availability.

If you need to get in contact over an academic or pastoral issue directly related to your child, the best way to begin is to email [info@rmays.com](mailto:info@rmays.com) and make sure that the name of the teacher you wish to contact is in the message heading. We hope you will appreciate that teachers will not be able to respond during the working school day, but they will do their best to respond as soon as they can, once students have left the site and any relevant meetings and training sessions have taken place.

We will not tolerate rudeness, threats or aggression of any kind. The school has powers to bar adults, who behave unacceptably, from the site.
