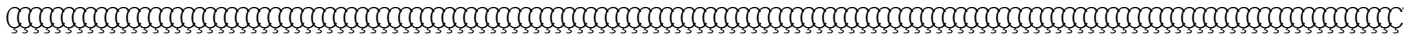


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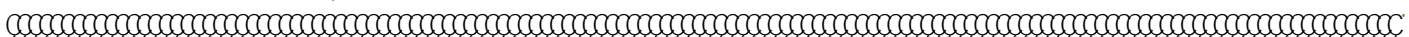
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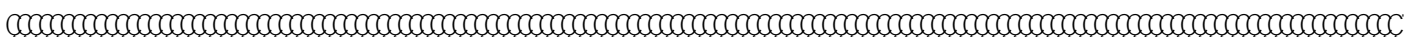
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Year 7 TOWN German Homework Tasks Term 3a

During this half term you should choose 3 of these tasks to complete. Your teacher will check once a week which homework tasks you have done. You have enough time to put effort and pride into each piece. Be proud of the work that you hand in, let it reflect you at your best. Make sure you label the piece of work with the title of the task!

<p>End of Year 7 Exams</p> <p>This half term you will do the first of your end of year exams.</p> <p>You will prepare and sit your role-play speaking task in the last week of the half term. Your teacher will guide you through this, and this will be another piece of homework set by your teacher.</p>	<p>Teach Me</p> <p>Teach someone at home something you have learnt in German this half term - it might be one lesson, or a series of lessons. Make sure you have evidence in your book of the lessons.</p>	<p>Design a Town</p> <p>Design a dream school and label it in German. Use the dictionary link below, or wait until after week 2, when you will have covered places in town in class.</p>	<p>Language Stones</p> <p>Check out Google for Language Stones. Paint a stone and write German words on them that you are learning this half term. Bring it in for your teacher to see. Be creative - not just a word written on a stone!</p>
	<p>Revision Game</p> <p>Create your own revision game. It should have on it as many German key words as possible, so you can use it as a support. Verbs, adjectives, connectives, time adverbs, qualifiers.</p>	<p>Key words</p> <p>Create a poster of key words from your Year 7 topics (family, hobbies, school) - Nouns, adjectives, time adverbs, connectives, qualifiers. Make it eye-catching and colourful.</p>	<p>A-Z of Towns</p> <p>Using the dictionary link below, find a word for each letter of the alphabet for things you can do in town or places in town. Make a list in English and German. Draw pictures as well. eg e = essen = to eat</p>

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
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
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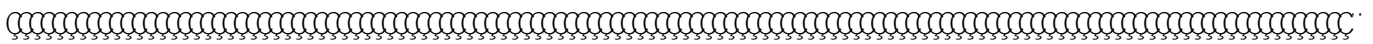
